MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
between
PIMA COUNTY INTERFAITH CIVIC EDUCATION ORGANIZATION
and
PIMA COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT

This MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (“**Memorandum**”) is between Pima County Interfaith Civic Education Organization (“**PCICEO**”), an Arizona non-profit corporation, and Pima County Community College District (“**PCC**”), a political subdivision of the State of Arizona.

BACKGROUND

- A. PCC is a two-year community college serving the residents of Pima County by providing affordable high quality education through diverse associate degree programs, career training programs, and continuing and adult education.
- B. PCICEO is a non-partisan, broad-based non-profit organization engaged in civic education of Pima County communities. PCICEO provides skill training and development, establishes and evaluates community-based initiatives, and conducts research and advocacy on various issues impacting local communities.
- C. PCICEO and PCC desire to collaborate and develop a strategic relationship that furthers the parties’ mission to serve the residents of Pima County.

PURPOSE

This Memorandum sets out the framework of the strategic relationship between the parties. Specific projects undertaken in furtherance of this strategic relationship shall be identified in subsequent agreements that identify the respective roles and responsibilities of the parties.

THEREFORE, the parties agree to collaborate as follows:

- 1. **COLLABORATION** Activities and services of the strategic relationships:
 - a) A partnership on grant and resource development projects when mutually beneficial to both parties;
 - b) Community training or education arrangements, including but not limited to student and staff leadership development, as appropriate;
 - c) Civic engagement activities, including but not limited to PCICEO community-wide accountability sessions, PCC staff time permitting;


- d) Research and strategic planning activities, including but not limited to participation in PCICEO'S strategy and education teams;
 - e) Multi-level advocacy engagements; and/or
 - f) Brochures and informational items may be exchanged and made available at each party's locations.
2. **DURATION.** This Memorandum shall be in effect for 5 years, commencing on the date of last signature below.
 3. **MODIFICATION; TERMINATION.** Either party may modify or terminate its participation in this relationship at any time by informing the other party in writing.


